



COVID-19 UPDATE

As we move forward to comply with new COVID guidelines with the rest of the world we have new policies in place. Please keep in mind that things are changing constantly, so you may be receiving multiple calls before your procedure. Your safety and health are our priority.

- You may be required to be tested for COVID-19 **UNLESS** you have had a positive COVID-19 test in the past 90 days. Once your physician has scheduled your surgery you will receive a call from one of our nurses to get this set up.
- **AMPSC will notify you ONLY if your test is positive.** If your test is negative, continue with pre-operative instructions provided.
- Once you are tested, it is recommended that you stay home until your procedure, as able, and wear a mask if in public locations.
- Adults (18 and older), your driver is able to come into our facility and we kindly ask they wear a mask the entire time they are in here. They will only be able to come back to the room at certain times.
- Pediatrics (17 and younger), only **ONE** parent/guardian is permitted to accompany you to your preparatory room.
- If you become ill or display symptoms of having COVID-19 such as cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, fever, or loss of taste/smell, call the surgery center to notify the staff immediately at **515-965-2200**.
